VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTION LEVY Kindergarten to Year 6

Under the current School Education Act, it is a requirement for schools to outline all voluntary contribution and charges for 2020. The contribution levy supplements consumables and resources in the eight curriculum areas: The Arts; English; Mathematics; Humanities and Social Science; Science, Technologies; Physical Education and LOTE (Language Other Than English). This contribution levy has been endorsed by the Ashdale School Board.

\$60 per child, Years K - 6

The quality of our teaching and learning program will be significantly enhanced if all families' pay the contribution.

Payment Options:

- Payment can be made at the same time as you order your child's Personal Requirements through Office Max
- Additional payment option is QKR! Option is available commencement of 2020.
- Directly to the front office. Ashdale Primary accepts cash, cheque, EFTPOS & credit card.
- Families may pay the Voluntary Contribution Levy in instalments. Please discuss this arrangement with our Manager Corporate Services.

1:1 Program

As part of an Ashdale Cluster initiative, Ashdale Primary School implemented the Apple 1:1 program and runs from Years 4 to 6. There may be different and/or additional items appearing on your child's Personal Requirements list, depending on the year of your child. At the bottom of lists from PP to Yr 6 there is a section 'Retain from Previous Years'. Items that are in this section can be used again, if they are in good condition.



SCHOOL FUNDRAISING FOR SPECIAL CAUSES

Ashdale Primary will support selected charities with causes related to the specific needs of students in the school or children in general.

The usual expectation for these events will be a gold coin donation to participate in free dress days and cake stall-type purchases.

P&C CONTRIBUTIONS

Ashdale Primary School P&C is responsible for the provision of a five day a week canteen service with paid employees, the school banking service and safety house program. They also organise community and charity events run through the year, as well as fundraising projects which raise much needed funds for projects and resources within the school. Initiatives which have been partly or fully funded by the P&C in recent years have been the Community Garden, Nature Play Areas, Library Upgrade, Classroom Libraries, Kiss 'n' Drive Weather Shelter, Broad-brimmed hats for all students and Teacher directed programs and resources.

Our P&C Association has a Fundraising contribution of **\$40 per family** which families are encouraged to pay. This can be paid at the same time as the School Voluntary Contribution —refer to payment option section. Amongst other things, your money goes towards: -

• Legal fees and insurances which enable the P&C, canteen & safety house program to function

After the above, the balance will be spent on: -

- 50% will be a joint collaboration with the school.
- 30% will be P & C Projects (P & C directed)
- 20% will be directed towards Teacher based projects/submissions.
