



## Year 4, 5 and 6 Macbook Program 2017

Dear families of new Year 4, 5 or 6 students in 2017, Ashdale offers a 1 to1 Macbook program for students in Yr 4,5 and 6. This program sees parents provide a Macbook for their child to use at school and at home. This is a voluntary program.

If you are interested in participating in the program, ordering and other details are below -

The portal to purchase the Macbook Air 13" laptop through Winthrop Australia will be open by Thursday 17<sup>th</sup> November and you can order at any time through this portal. The MacBook from Winthrop comes with the standard 1 year manufacturer's warranty and then an additional year's warranty under Australian consumer law. You will notice on the website that Winthrop is offering the 3 year AppleCare Warranty as an optional extra at a discounted rate to parents.

While the Macbook Air 11" was slightly smaller, the 13" has the benefit of having a slightly larger screen. It is still very light and many of our students have chosen this size over the 11" previously and have found it just as portable. Some Apple resellers may have remaining stock of the MacAir 11" and be offering special deals due to it being discontinued, it is worthwhile to always "shop" around for the best deal for you. Whilst it doesn't matter to the school where you purchase the laptop, our partnership with Winthrop is to ensure the best price for the device offered and to have the best service option for parents through them.

A benefit to purchasing through Winthrop is that they do service the MacBooks that are bought from them through our school, so if there is a warranty issue, they will send a technician out to the school to resolve the problem. If the MacBook is purchased elsewhere, you would need to take it to a store to be looked at.

Parents are reminded that the program is optional and if their child does not participate in the program they will have a level of access to school owned devices during school time.

If you have questions regarding the purchase through the portal or other vendors, please contact the school for clarification.

### **Optional Accessories**

Parents may purchase optional items through Winthrop, online or any retail store. Of the optional accessories a carry case is considered essential.

### **Additional**

A portable hard drive is also required for backing up. This is an essential item. It can be purchased from retail stores such as Officeworks, Dick Smith or Harvey Norman. A 500GB or a 1T is fine. Prices can range from \$70 - \$100. It does not have to be Mac compatible, as the mac will reformat it when preparing it for the initial backup.

**Insurance**

Protecsure has insurance that is specifically for laptops that are taken outside the home. This may be required if your Home and Contents Insurance does not cover the MacBook outside of the home. Parents are advised to check their policies. School insurance does not cover student laptops.

Protecsure Insurance is available through the Winthrop Portal.

**Ordering process:**

- the portal that is used for ordering usually closes over the Xmas/New Year period
- machines can be delivered to the school or your home
- If the machine is delivered to school, you will be notified to come and collect it.
- the machines can be used over the holidays and will have school software and settings put on at the beginning of next year.
